HEALTH & SAFETY STANDARDS

For the entire duration of the conference the guests have to follow the hygiene regulations, social distancing regulations and further SARS-CoV-2 health and safety standards currently in effect at smac Museum and in the federal state of Saxony, Germany.

Please note that participation is only permitted for persons with a negative Covid-19-test result or for those who are fully vaccinated or have proof of a full recovery from the illness.

1. Admission requirements

Current, negative test result (PCR-test max. 48h ago or antigen rapid test that has been taken under 24 hours ago under supervision) with a personalized certificate in print or digital.

Or

Vaccination certificate to proof a full immunization (as of 14 days after the last vaccination) with a vaccine that is licensed in the EU.

Or

In case of a recovery from COVID-19 infection: proof of a positive PCR-test result, which is at least 28 days old and no older than 6 months. If the recovery was more than 6 months ago, additional proof of at least one vaccination that has been given at least 14 days ago with an EU-licensed vaccine is required.

Additionally each day upon entry all participants must register their contact information in case contact tracing becomes necessary.

This can be done via check in through the German "Corona-Warn-App". Registration via "Corona-Warn-App" works by scanning a QR-Code under the app's Check-In-function. by filling in a contact tracing form in paper.

2. Social distancing

Be considerate of other guests following the sneeze and cough etiquette, please maintain the minimum distance to those around you (at least 1,5 meters) and wash your hands regularly.

3. Mandatory Mask

Inside the museum you are obligated to wear a medical mask. The mask may be taken off when the person is in his or her assigned seat. It is also possible to take off the mask during lunch and coffee breaks when eating and drinking at the tables in the foyer.

The lecture hall and the other rooms of the museum are equipped with a modern ventilation system which ensures a permanent exchange of air.
